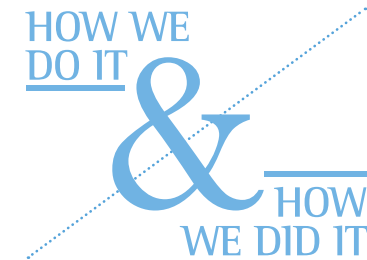

See you soon in Rome, the Eternal City with the special atmosphere of in the Jubileum year!

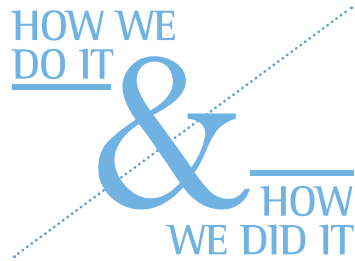
